THE BAYROL end-of-season routine in 2 phases

During the cold season, BAYROL recommends not lowering the water level in the pool if possible and running the filter system for a few hours during winter. This is called active or dynamic winterisation.

Here are the steps you should follow:

PHASE 1

It's AUTUMN and the swimming season is over.
The water temperature is between 20°C and 15°C.



- 1 Leave the filtration running**
(the number of hours per day of filtration must be at least equal to the water temperature divided by 2) and continue to clean your pool regularly (skimmer basket, water line, etc.) and maintain the pH between 7.0 and 7.4

- **Bordnet / ph-Minus**



- 2 Maintain the disinfectant level**
using the automatic treatment or by adding Chlorilong POWER 5 long-lasting chlorine tablets.

- 3 Add a winterising product**
to start preventing limescale deposits and algae growth right away.

PHASE 2

It's WINTER and the water temperature is below 15°C.

- 4 Thoroughly descale the filter.**
After at least 12 hours, wash and rinse the filter.

- **Decalcit Filter**

- 5 Carry out a shock treatment**
with your regularly used product to eradicate all impurities.

- **Chlorifix® / Chloryte**

- 6 Add a second dose of winterising product**

to ensure complete protection of the water and equipment until you reopen your pool, leaving the filtration system running for around 4 hours a day*.

ALTERNATIVE PHASE 2

You would like to stop filtration and close your pool completely? Follow steps 1 to 5 above, then:

- 6 Lower the water level**
to a frost-proof level i.e. below the skimmers.

- 7 Empty the external pipes and areas that may freeze**

Drain the heat pump, circulation pump and filter.

- 8 Install ice pressure pads**
to prevent the ice from damaging pool walls.

- 9 Add a winterising product**
Puripool Super prevents algae growth and limescale deposits.

- 10 Protect the pool with a suitable cover**

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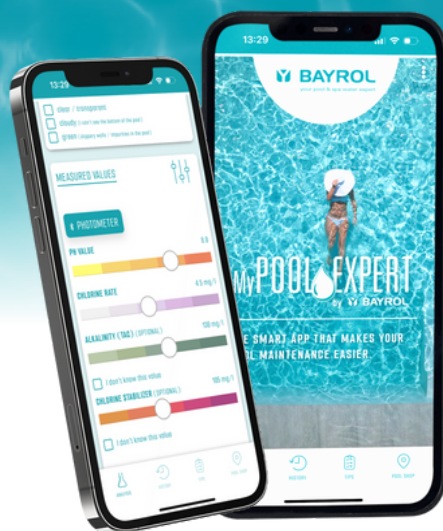

*Important: leave the filtration system running for at least 4 hours a day, at times when the risk of frost is greatest. During periods of frost, leave the filtration system running 24 hours a day to prevent ice forming in the pool's hydraulic system.
